## Two on theft of car key charges

Two men who allegedly stole car keys, a leather wallet and a mobile phone from a home in Milton Malsor will appear at Northampton Crown Court in January.

Brendan O'Connell, aged 18, of Hester Street, Semilong, Northampton, and Lucan Parsi, aged 25, of Five Acres Fold, Briar Hill, Northampton, are both charged with entering a house in Green Street last June.

O'Connell is also charged with stealing a Mercedes Benz and driving it while disqualified and without insurance, as well as aggravated vehicle taking, driving while disqualified and without insurance on November 12.

Parsi is also charged with travelling in a stolen Range Rover on June 8.

The pair appeared at Northampton Magistrates' Court, where O'Connell pleaded not guilty to all charges. Parsi offered no indication of plea.

O'Connell was remanded in custody. Parsi was released on unconditional bail.
